I performed more than 7500 coronary procedures (femoral, radial, ulnar, brachial and terminal radial), more than 3000 coronary PTCA and more than 600 P-PTCA as first operator. Routine use of IVUS (Volcano and Boston), FFR measurements, more than 300 OCT coronary procedure. High skill in rotational atherectomy even in most difficult procedures (Boston), advanced cardiac support (conterpulsation, Impella LP) and temporary electrical stimulation.

Since 2018 I experienced in peripheral and coronary shock wave.

In 2012 I built up a program for the treatment of complex CTO procedure in my center, with Dott. Garbo proctoring. As first operator I treated more than 200 complex CTO both by antegrade and retrograde approach. Nowadays our institute is a reference for such procedure.

I performed more than 150 peripheral procedures (carotid and femoro-iliac district).

In the 2015 I started cardiac structural interventions: >100 TAVR implantation: Accurate, Sapien 3 and Corevalve
